

Almost 100 years ago, a group of leaders from Chesterton and Valparaiso gathered. To dream. To hope. To imagine reaching the kids of Liberty Township with the Gospel. In 1927, a Sunday School was born, taking root and thriving, even in the midst of the Great Depression. In 1941, that Sunday School became a church that grew in Porter County as the world went to war. Those early pioneers laid the foundation for who we are today — three different campuses throughout Northwest Indiana — reaching our region with the Gospel.

When I think about the history of our church, I am filled with hope. God can do anything! Start a school during the Great Depression? Launch a church as the world goes to war? Yes, and Yes! Nothing limits what God can do in our world. The women and men who launched Liberty Bible Church were guided by values that were close to the heart of God. A love for the Gospel. A desire to take the Gospel to the next generation. A willingness to give sacrificially of their time, their gifts, their finances — to partner with God in His Word in the world. A desire to plant churches for people to come to know Jesus.

When God's people believe Him, and live a life expecting Him to keep His promises, nothing is impossible.

One of my favorite promises in the Scriptures is in Isaiah 56, words first spoken by the Prophet and then repeated by Jesus:

**Oh yes, my house of worship will be known as a house of prayer for all people." The Decree of the Master, God himself, who gathers in the exiles of Israel: "I will gather others also, gather them in with those already gathered."**

God promises to make His house, His people — a house of prayer for all people. He promises to gather His people to Himself, to bring in those not yet gathered. What a beautiful vision from our God.

We are at another defining moment as a church. With national church attendance declining significantly, and so many people walking away from faith, it is time we remind ourselves of God's promises, and live in light of the promise that He will gather us to Himself...and gather others, also.

As we go into this next season of ministry together, I know God will continue to be faithful to His promises. I am filled with anticipation. I am ready to commit myself to joining God's work, of keeping His promise to make His house a house of prayer for all people.

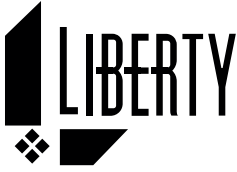

# OUR HISTORY

## Timeline of Liberty Bible Church

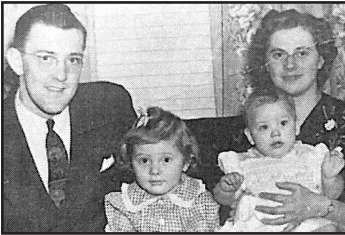


### 1927

Fred and Hanna Johnson, members from First Baptist Church of Valparaiso, gather to dream and launch a Sunday School to reach the kids of Liberty Township.

### 1927 – 1941

Volunteers lead the way to launch Cole's Corner Union Sunday School; then later Liberty Township Sunday School was established to teach kids about Jesus. As the school grew, preachers from Moody Bible Institute and Northern Baptist Seminary began preaching to the adults as Liberty grew from a Sunday School to a church.



### 1959

Dr. Thomas McDill oversaw both the building of the new worship center, now called South Peak, and a new educational wing for children and students. Liberty joined the Evangelical Free Church of America and began to grow significantly as these new buildings opened the space to reach even more kids with the Gospel.



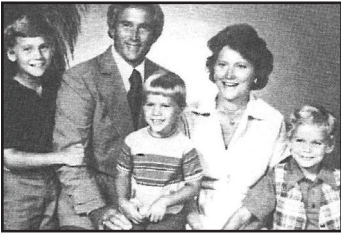
### 1970s

Pastor Wes Johnson was known for serving in a way that deeply connected people into the church. Liberty Bible Church was becoming more than a place to learn. It was growing into a place with a real community of believers. Liberty became a welcoming church that felt like family.



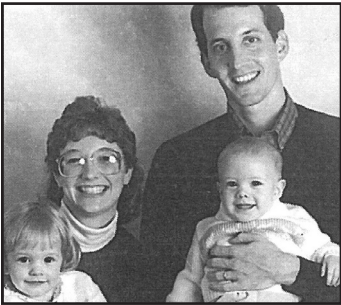


## 1980s



As the congregation continued to grow, Pastor Gale Newman looked to the future, dreaming of a new worship center to hold the growing congregation. Liberty's plans began and in a few short years, on a Sunday morning, the church began one service in the older worship center and sang their way into our current worship center.

## 1990s



With the creation of the new worship center, the congregation continued to grow significantly under Pastor Bill Jones leadership. Excitedly, Liberty Bible Church looked to the future. We expanded the building, creating the gym that now hosts up to 1,000 for our Saturday soccer ministry.

## 2010s

With our Chesterton Campus out of space for growth, rather than looking to continue to expand our Chesterton Campus, we looked east — to LaPorte! Liberty planted a new campus in the City of LaPorte, to reach the people of LaPorte County. With a desire to deepen our commitment to church planting, we became aware of a church building available close to Valparaiso University! Because of the incredible generosity of our church, we were able to immediately purchase the building, and our Valpo Campus was born.

## 2022

Tim and Misty Spanburg and their family joined Liberty as Lead Pastor. Tim, along with the Long Range Planning Team, are asking the church — what might God have for us in the next 30 years together? Our desire is for Liberty Bible Church to be a welcoming place that once again feels like a family.

# THE JOURNEY OF A GIVER

The Journey of a Giver focuses on behaviors and attitudes of our hearts rather than on amounts or percentages, further transforming us into the likeness of Christ. Each step of the journey represents growth in a lifestyle of generosity and sacrifice.

## AN INITIAL GIVER

decides to give for the first time, out of a response to God's Word. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the church with this gift.



## A CONSISTENT GIVER

decides to give something consistently to exercise the discipline of giving regularly. To learn the behavior of consistency, it can be helpful for a gift to be made as an on-line recurring gift. Regardless of whether a gift is given on-line or in person, being consistent requires discipline.



## AN INTENTIONAL GIVER

begins to think about their giving in relation to other things on which they spend their money. For example, this type of giver begins asking the question, "Why am I giving more to AT&T than I am giving to God? Should I be giving to God more than I give for my mortgage each month?" This giver starts to make their giving an intentional choice that reflects how they prioritize and spend their money. This may be the point of intentionality when someone begins to tithe, reflecting intentionality about a certain amount/percentage they want to give to God.

## A SURRENDERED GIVER

recognizes the cost Christ paid on the cross for us and is surrendered to honoring God with 100% of their resources as a result. They give in a way that changes them. Their giving determines their spending/saving rather than their spending/saving determining their giving. A Surrendered Giver isn't concerned with what they ARE giving but more concerned with what they're NOT giving and why. They seek to honor God with 100% of what He has given them, whether direct monetary giving or a God-honoring use of an existing resource like a home or a vehicle.

## A LIFETIME GIVER

thinks about the long-term effects of generosity rather than month-to-month generosity or even year-to-year. They make short-term decisions which may have long term effects as it relates to their generosity capacity. A Lifetime Giver might be someone who has a giving goal which governs their larger-ticket decisions. They make lifetime or longer-term giving commitments that govern his/her larger-item purchases like homes, cars, investments, etc...

**These are not steps you ascend to get to God, but simply a way to evaluate your growth in generosity. Scripture encourages us to grow in every facet of our walk with Christ, including the grace of giving. (2 Corinthians 8:1-7)**





# NEXT STEPS

We ask for you to pray, to gather, to give...

## PRAY

*We desire to be a 'house of prayer for all people'.*

We believe that when God's people pray and seek Him,  
He accomplishes His promises through His people.

He has promised to gather those who do not yet know Him, to Himself, so everything in our church starts with prayer. Pray that God would draw more people to Himself. Pray that God would make known to you how you can serve and give in this season. Pray that He would make clear the next step He is asking each of us to take in our discipleship journey.

## GATHER

We want all of our church gathered together in this season.  
Commit fully to the goal of 100% engagement.  
Commit all that God asks of you in this season.

## GIVE

God works powerfully through generous people. Give in a way that stretches you to a deeper level of generosity, a deeper level of trust for God to provide for you. Give expecting God to work in power through you as you become more like Him.

## One Fund Explanation

# ONE MISSION. ONE FUND.

**A traditional capital campaign focuses mostly on people who are already giving. These people are asked to continue giving what they currently are, as well as to start giving toward something else...like a building or special project. That isn't what the Gather Initiative is about.**

## ***GATHER*** is an initiative about **DISCIPLESHIP and THE MISSION OF GOD** **through Liberty Bible Church.**

Gather will be a 'one fund' initiative, meaning ALL of our giving goes toward carrying out the mission and expansion of the ministry space over the next two years. It's all one mission, so it's all one budget.

### ***Why does this distinction matter?***

We want everyone at Liberty to be transformed through the Gather Initiative. Through a 'one fund' initiative, we will more successfully invite everyone to take steps into uncharted territory with their generosity, regardless of how much they give. For those not yet on the giving journey, they too will have the opportunity to take their first step.

Also, God has given Liberty one mission. Our general operating budget is a huge part of this mission, and our facility improvements are a huge part of that mission. A traditional capital campaign can easily divide our focus in two ways: 1) mission and 2) the building. But we do not believe our buildings are separate from our mission. It's all one mission, so it's all one budget.

The Gather Initiative will be for two years. In those two years, every dollar\* that is given to Liberty Bible Church will go to the Gather Initiative as we seek to launch Liberty Bible Church into our next season together.

*\*The one element of our budget that will remain separate is our Benevolent Fund. We will continue to take offering for Benevolence that is separate from our Gather Initiative.*

# FAQs

## *How long is my commitment?*

We are asking that everyone make a two-year commitment to the Gather Initiative. The fulfillment period for your commitment will begin March 2023 and culminate at the end of February 2025.

## *What are you asking me to do?*

**Pray! First and foremost, pray.** We desire to be a house of prayer for all people, so it all starts with us seeking God. We believe each person is made by God, loved by God, and God desires to lead us into a fruitful and flourishing life. Start with prayer.

**Join a group this season** if you aren't already a part of one.

**Give.** We ask that you spend a committed time — praying and seeking how God might call you to make a sacrificial financial commitment to further God's mission through Liberty Bible Church.

## **Come to Commitment Sunday.**

We ask that you join us on February 12 for Commitment Sunday and prepare for a life-changing worship service that will be remembered as a defining moment for our church and your faith.

## *Are there additional ways besides finances that I can give more toward the Gather Initiative?*

Be creative as you explore ways you and your family can give. You might have stock, property, or a stored resource that God has blessed you with in the past that He might call you to give during this time. Please let us know if you need assistance with facilitating gifts of property or stock. We would be happy to help you with that.

## *What if I am in debt? Am I supposed to give?*

If you are currently seeking to pay off debt, that is awesome! We celebrate that with you! We would be happy to help you on that journey and recommend resources and possible classes that might help you. However, we believe that being in debt does not prevent us from generosity. Giving isn't about what God wants from you; it's about what God wants for you. So it can be our joy and privilege to give at all times. ### ***What if I have never given to Liberty Bible Church before?***

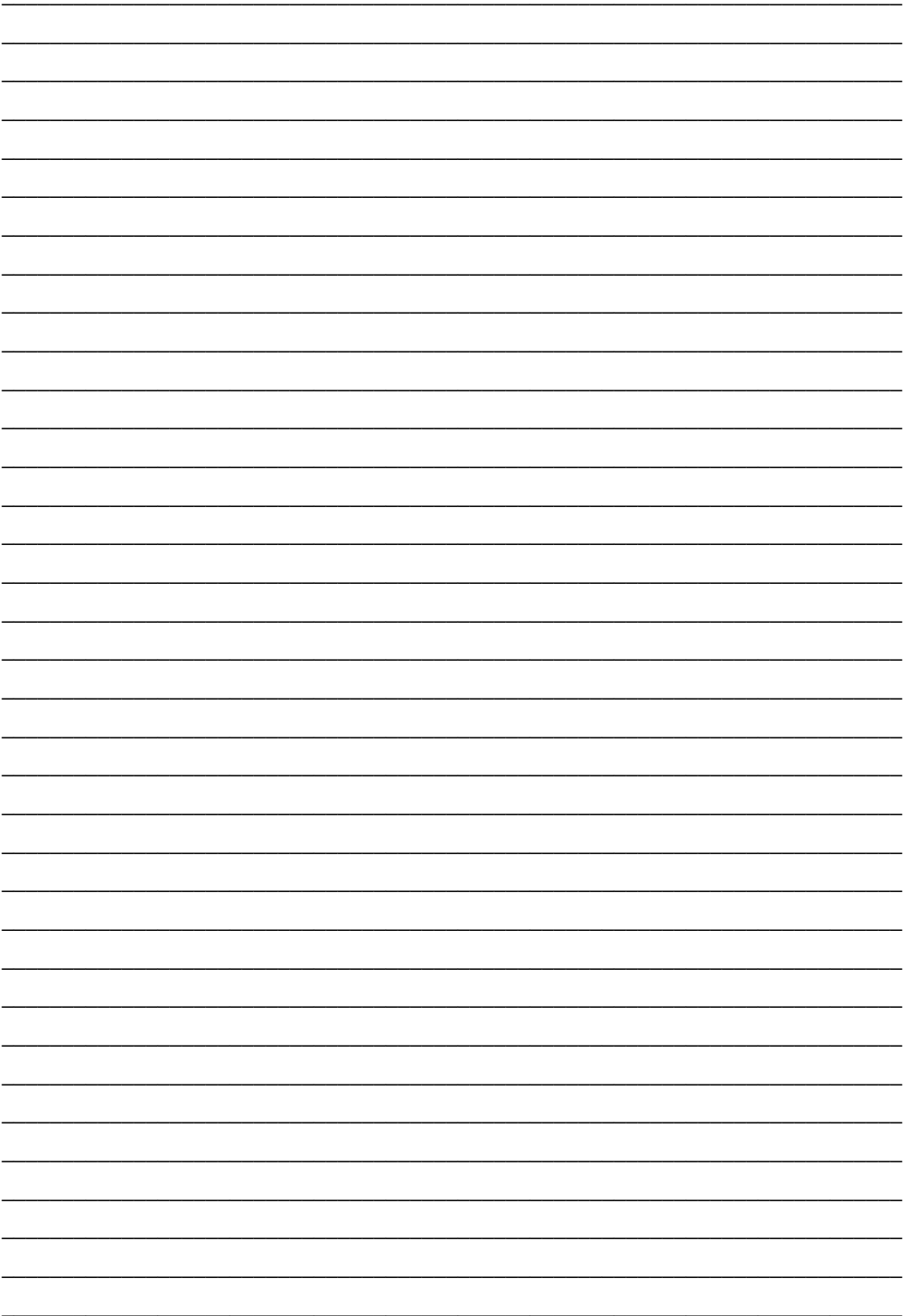
The Gather Initiative was explicitly designed with you in mind. Gather is a 'one fund' generosity initiative. It is different from a traditional campaign where you are called to not only regularly give to the church's general fund but also asked to give to a special project or building fund – creating TWO steps for people who aren't yet giving. By doing a 'one fund' Gather Initiative, we're saying that every dollar given to Liberty Bible Church over the next two years goes to Gather. You don't need to be a regular giver to participate. Gather is a call to sacrificial, gospel-centered generosity for everyone at Liberty. If you have never given, this is your chance to join us and commit to God's mission through our church. We hope you will.

### ***What if I am new to Liberty?***

Gather is about the vision of our church. We believe that the local church is the most compelling mission to give toward, it is God's Plan A to bring His salvation into the world.
